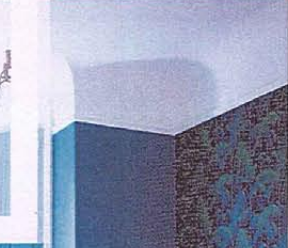

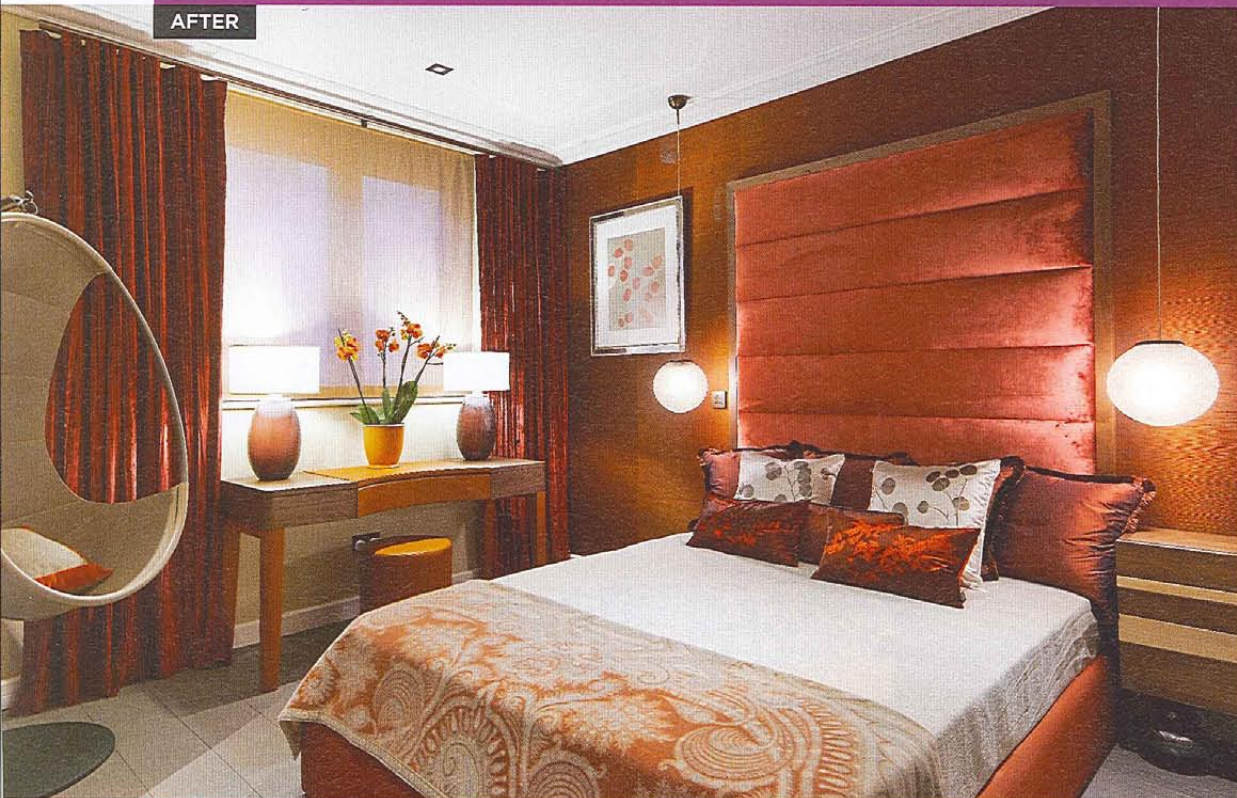

For this bedroom in a west London home, interior design studio Keir Townsend was inspired by the idea of an urban retreat that would provide an escape from the hustle and bustle of the city. 'Colour, tone and a plethora of textures were layered to create a feeling of cocooning warmth,' says design director Keira Townsend.

The fabrics included velvet for the headboard, etched silk for the cushions and cashmere for bed throws. Straw

wallpaper contrasts with smooth walnut and ash bedside tables, which have shapely cast metal legs. The pendant and desk lights are in hand-blown glass.

The majority of the joinery is bespoke, including the walnut and leather dressing table, which has a pop-up mirror, the matching leather pouffe, the bookcase, which is in ash, and the bedside tables.

A final luxury touch is the leather swing chair, which offers the ultimate cocoon.
